

Dual credit programs are Ministry of Education approved programs that allows students who are under the age of 21, and earning secondary credits, to earn college or apprenticeship courses. Students, if successful, earn both a college credit which is recorded on the college record, and a high school credit which is recorded on the Ontario Student Transcript.

College-Delivered

In a college-delivered dual credit course, students take a college course. This course is delivered solely by a college instructor and supported by a secondary school teacher.

The Work-4-Credits (Cooperative Education) Program provides employed adults who are unable to attend day school, the opportunity to earn high school credits toward their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) while at work receiving pay.

- One credit can be earned for every 110 hours on the job
